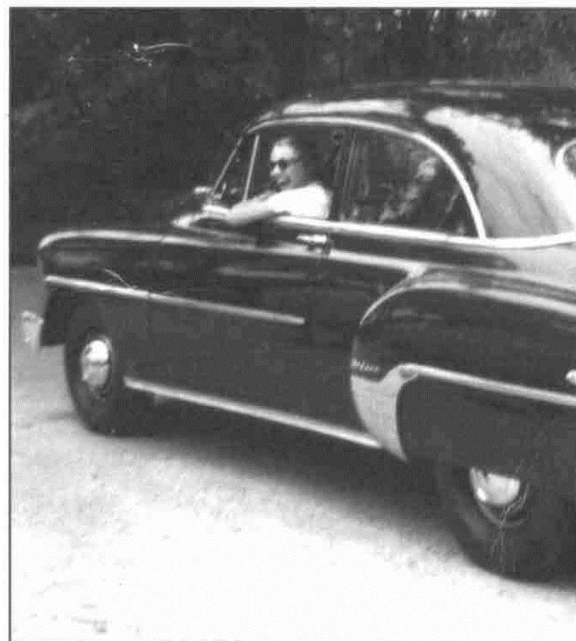
### Sunday, October 29<sup>th</sup> – "Oktoberfest at St. Matthias Church" –
