A wife was curious when she found an old negative in a drawer and had it



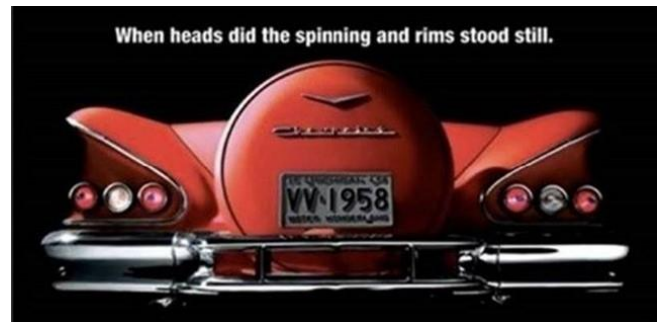
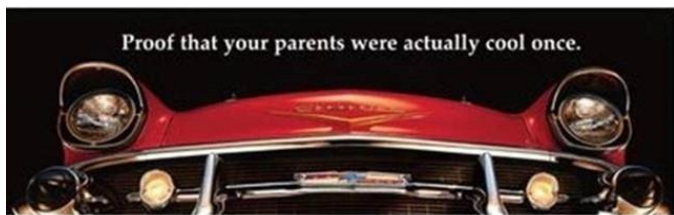
made into a print. She was pleasantly surprised to see that they were
