

#### 5/16/2021 - MPOTAC Car Tour Flier:

- 9:00am Meet at Bedwell Bayfront Park
  which is located at the end of Marsh
  Road. We will meet inside Bedwell
  Bayfront park in the parking spaces just
  beyond the front gate on the right by
  the pump house Bathrooms are down
  the road at the parking lot on the right
- At the Marsh road light take a left out of park to Bayfront expressway - continue across Dumbarton bridge
- 7.6 miles take the Thornton Ave Exit stay in right lane
- 7.9 miles stay in right lane to turn right on Thornton Ave
- 8.5 miles turn right on Marshlands Road
- 8.7 miles enter Don Edward Preserve Park
- 9 miles left turn into parking lot loop through parking lot there is a long stretch of parking where we can all line up together

- 20 minute stop at park visitor center at the bottom with restrooms
  - Leave parking lot turn right and head out of the park
  - 9.8 miles left turn on to Thornton Ave stay in the right lanes
  - 10.5 miles turn right at light to get back on Hwy 84 for 2.5 miles
  - 12.2 miles stay in center lane over Hwy 880 (becomes Decoto road)
  - 14.7 miles turn right onto Alvarado-Niles
    Canyon road stay in the center lane
    (purple lotus temple on the right)
  - 16.4 miles Turn left on Nursery Road (CA Nursery Historical Park on right)
  - 16.5 miles turn right onto Mission Blvd
  - 17.6 miles turn left on Niles Canyon Road
  - 20.4 look to the left to see the old train and spur tracks
  - 21 miles look right did you see Frosty the Snowman or Snoopy on the hill on the right.

24.3 miles turn left at intersection and then immediate left into corner parking lot - Sunol Water Temple can be viewed at the gate

20 minute stop - corner fruit stand for historical photos and bathroom break on Pleasanton Sunol Road

Right turn out parking on Niles

- 24.4 turn right on the main street
- 24.7 left turn on to Kilkare Road back on to Hwy 84
- 32 miles turn left into historic Niles
- 32.2 Park in Parking lot on the right and enjoy an hour and half for antique shopping and food

Reconvene to travel as a group, returning to the West Bay:

- 33.2 miles take a left out of the parking lot onto Niles Blvd
- 32.6 veer left
- 32.8 right turn onto Mission Blvd
- 33.1 right turn onto Mowry Ave into historic Centerville District
- 33.9 veer right onto Peralta Blvd
- 35.5 turn right onto Fremont Blvd
- 35.9 turn left onto Thornton Blvd
- 36.9 merge onto HWY 880 to Dumbarton bridge for 1 mile stay in right lane
- 37.9 take Exit 21 -
- 38.3 turn left onto Decoto Rd and merge onto CA 84 West
- 41.2 you are now going through the toll plaza

48.5 miles total round trip car tour today!
