87-year-old driver wins Peking to Paris rally for third time!



After 8,500 miles, the 7th Peking to Paris Motor Challenge

ended with 87-year-old Gerry Crown and teammate Matt Bryson posting their third victory, though by a margin of just two minutes.

The 36-day slog through 12 countries ended with the checkered flag waved by Prince Constantino Paolo Borghese, great nephew of Prince Scipione Borghese, winner of the first Peking to Paris auto rally in 1907.



“Our third win in the Leyland was the toughest yet but it was also very enjoyable,” said Crown,

adding that, *“What we really needed though was a few more 87-year old’s in the field to keep me company.”*
