#### The Niles Canyon Railway

Karen and I had our hearts set on the October 6<sup>th</sup> Niles/Sunol train trip, and when it was cancelled my first thought was "that's too bad I was looking forward to that trip" then when I announced it to Karen she said "I was really looking forward to the tour out there and train ride". A few minutes later we came to our senses. So on Sunday morning I pulled the old 1924 Chevrolet truck out of the garage and headed to Sunol via the old Lincoln Highway, Pergola Dublin Rd. to Pleasanton, then Foothill Rd. to Sunol. Foothill Road is so nice, winding through the tree shrouded foothills on the East side of the Dublin mountain range, a real step back in time. On arrival at the Sunol depot and securing a premier parking spot I could see the steam locomotive sitting there

lightly huffing, exhausting a little steam

here and there, water dripping from an apparent overfilled tank, and the engineer, out



of the cab standing alongside one of the driving wheels tapping on an uncooperative stuck valve. Save that, it appeared to be ready to go to work. Weather could not have been better, so after purchasing our tickets we boarded

transcontinental railroad right of way that originally continued on into Oakland where you boarded a ferry to your final destination, San Francisco. The leisurely ride was delightful. We had lunch at Joe's Tavern in Niles with outside "sidewalk" seating, and then only had time to go through one of the many antique shops before it was time to walk back to the depot and board for our return trip back to Sunol. Nothing equals the sound of that locomotive steam whistle and the huffin' and puffin' sounds as it pulled us back up the mild grade to Sunol. Once back in Sunol, due

to numerous requests lots of pictures were taken and I've included a few here. Our return trip home took us West, down Niles Canyon Rd. where we followed the train for a while, waving at all the passengers as it wound its way back to Niles, Then just after the road passes under the tracks we turned right and headed up Palomares Rd. which after several miles took us over the hills and into Castro Valley and Hayward. What a wonderful day, so glad we went.
